(Guatemala City, Guatemala 19 - 23 September 2022)

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Location and date

The LACAC/Korea Seminar on "Airport Development and ORAT (Operational Readiness Activation and Transition)" will be held on September 19 and 23, 2022, in Guatemala City, Guatemala.

2. Venue

8. Suggested Attire

The dress code for the opening session will be formal attire and casual dress for the work sessions.

For the closing dinner on September 22, 2022, semi-formal attire is suggested.

9. Temperature

In Guatemala City, temperatures of approximately 16 °C - at 25 °C are expected in September, with chances of rain in the afternoons or nights.

10. Exchange currency

The national currency is Quetzal (Q). Exchange currency (subject to variation) is US\$ 1 to Q 7.73

11. Credit and debit cards

The international credit cards usually accepted in hotels, stores and restaurants are: American Express, MasterCard, Visa, and debit cards with the Electron logo.

12. Vaccines and medical services

It is necessary to have completed the vaccination doses against COVID 19 or carry a PCR or antigen test before entering the country. Public and private hospitals, which are available to tourists, attend emergencies 24 hours a day.

13. General Information

Guatemala City is located in Central America with a land area of 108,889 km2 and is bordered to the west and north by Mexico, to the east by Belize and the Gulf of Honduras, to the southeast by Honduras and El Salvador, and to the south by the Pacific Ocean.

It has a variety of shopping centers, restaurants, bars, cafes.

14. Language

The official language of Guatemala is Spanish, with English being spoken by most people involved in tourist activities.

15. Tourist attractions

The Guatemalan Tourism Entity INGUAT offers all kinds of material (maps, guides, brochures) and useful information to guide you within Guatemala City.

16. Electricity

In Guatemala City the standard outlet voltage is in the range of 110 / 120 volts.

17. Taxes and tips

The purchase tax is included in the consumer prices (12%). Tips in restaurants are not included in the bill and normally 10% of the value of consumption is considered as a tip.

18. Local time

Guatemala's time zone is in Coordinated Universal Time -6 (UTC -6 / time zone -6).

19. Business hours

The Shopping Centers are open from Monday to Sunday continuously from 09:00 hrs. until 8:00 p.m.

20. Safety recommendations

Safety recommendations are common to every city, such as carrying only the necessary money, not unnecessarily displaying valuable jewelry, requesting safe taxi services at the hotel of your choice to get around. The use of yellow taxis or the Uber platform is recommended.
