



SMS in ANAC



- ANAC requires civil aviation service providers under its regulation to establish and implement an SMS (part of the SSP).
- The focus of the SMS is the effectiveness in identifying and resolving the systemic deficiencies of these organizations that may affect safety.

From 2018 onwards, we began implementing a model for assessing the maturity of SMS processes, which allows for better assessment for decision-making.










5.4.2 States shall promote the establishment of safety information sharing or exchange networks among users of the aviation system, and facilitate the sharing and exchange of safety information, unless national law provides otherwise."



Art. 75. ANAC must develop initiatives, in collaboration with the civil aviation industry, to **share operational safety data and information**.

§ 1º The initiatives must aim to improve the processes related do safety assurance;

§ 2º Mechanisms for confidentiality and protection of data and information arising from the initiatives mentioned in § 1º of this article must be established.

- □ Brazilian Collaborative Safety Teams → Brazilian Aviation Safety Teams (BAST)
- The main objective is, together with the Civil Aviation Service Providers (PSAC) and the civil aviation community, to make efforts towards the safety of civil aviation in Brazil, bringing it to par with the safest regions in the world
- ☐ The current organizational structure of BAST was defined through Resolution No. 399, of December 12, 2016

Brazilian Aviation Safety Teams – BAST















- ANAC is responsible for the executive secretariat of BAST groups
- Group meetings take place 4 (four) times a year in a hybrid format or by videoconference
- Scheduled dates (preferably, the meeting takes place on Thursdays in March, June, September and November)
 - BHEST 1st Thursday of the month
 - BGAST 2nd Thursday of the month
 - BCAST 3rd Thursday of the month
 - BAIST 4th Thursday of the month


