

XXV Extraordinary Assembly of LACAC

(Santiago, Chile, 08 April 2024)

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Location and date

The XXV Extraordinary Assembly of LACAC will be held on 08 April 2024, in the city of Santiago, Chile.

2. Venue

The meeting will take place at the NH Collection Plaza Santiago hotel, located at Av. Vitacura 2610, Las Condes, Santiago.

3. Arriving at the airport and transport

The international airlines that fly to Santiago arrive at the Arturo Merino Benítez Airport, where the delegates will be received upon arrival of their flight by DGAC personnel, to provide them with facilities during their passage through Customs, International Police, and SAG. Consequently, **it is of utmost importance that delegates send their flight itineraries to the email** <u>rai@dgac.gob.cl</u>, **no later than April 1, 2024**, in order to be able to make the necessary coordination in sufficient time.

The DGAC will not provide transportation for the airport-hotel-airport transfer. At the international arrivals exit of the Airport there is a formal Public Transportation Center, separate from the public area, to request official transportation service to the destination hotel. It is recommended not to use informal public transport located outside the passenger terminal. Regarding the scheduled visits to FIDAE 2024 on April 9 and 10, the DGAC will offer transportation to the delegates, with the departure and arrival point being the hotel venue **NH Collection Park Santiago**.

4. Participants registration

Registration of delegates will take place on April 7 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and April 8 from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at the hotel hosting the event.

5. Opening

The opening ceremony will take place on Monday, April 8 at 9:00 a.m. at the NH Collection Park Santiago Hotel (Amsterdam Room).

6. Language in which the meeting will be done

The meeting will take place in Spanish – English and will have simultaneous translation.

8. Suggested attire

The attire for the opening session will be a formal suit and casual attire for the work sessions.

10. Money Exchange

The official currency in Santiago is the Peso. The exchange rate (subject to variation) is approximately \$974 pesos for \$1. It is recommended that money exchanges always be carried out in authorized currency exchange houses or banks.

11. Credit and debit cards

International credit cards usually accepted in hotels, shops, and restaurants are: American Express, MasterCard, VISA.

13. Medical insurance

All participants, including authorities and delegates attending the event, are advised to purchase travel assistance insurance or have valid international medical insurance in case of any health-related eventuality.

14. Language

The official language of Chile is Spanish.

15. Voltage

In Chile the standard output voltage is 220 volts. Plugs are two or three pins. It is recommended to bring a laptop adapter with you if necessary.



16. Taxes and tips

Sales and services are charged with Value Added Tax (VAT), which is currently 19% and is generally included in the price. The recommended tip in restaurants is 10% of the total. Usually, the tip is suggested at the end of the bill, and it is voluntary to consider it or not. In transportation (taxis or other means) it is not customary to tip drivers.

17. Time zone

Santiago's time zone from April to September is GMT-4.

18. Commercial hours

Business in general is open from Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Shopping centers (malls) and large stores are open from Monday to Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Bank hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

19. Safety recommendations

Safety recommendations are common to every city, such as carrying only the necessary money, not unnecessarily displaying valuable jewelry, cameras, or cell phones, and requesting safe taxi services

at the hotel of your choice. The use of the Uber platform is recommended.

20. Travel documents

Foreign citizens must be accredited with a passport. Depending on the country of origin, they may require a visa; it is suggested that the delegates make appropriate inquiries in advance at the Chilean Consulates in their respective countries.
